

# Conditions of Participation | Privacy | Covid-19 Rules

### Conditions of Participation

- 1.) You comply with the valid regulations of the Austrian Ministry of Health and the rules of conduct for Covid-19 (page 3 "Covid Rules").
- 2.) The Vienna Calling 21k is a sporting event. You are not allowed to participate in the run if you are ill or injured. We reserve the right to disqualify you for giving false information during registration, shortcutting the course, obstructing other participants, changing the official race number, current or past suspension by a sports federation or an anti-doping agency. Participation on bicycles, inline skates, scooters, skateboards and similar is not permitted. For safety reasons, escorts on such means of transport are also not permitted.
- 3.) Your registration and payment for the Vienna Calling 21k can be done either via the ÖLV registration platform ATHMIN or, if you are not a member of an ÖLV club or do not want to participate in the championship, via the registration platform of Enterprise Sport Promotion GmbH. A late registration on site is not possible without exception.
- 4.) You will receive a start number from us, which is used for timekeeping and must be worn during the race. In times of Covid-19 it is essential that we as organisers know exactly who our participants are.
- 5.) Please follow the instructions of the organisation team and the emergency services before, during and after the run.
- 6.) You agree that we as the organisers do not accept any liability for theft, accidents, injuries, infections caused by pathogens or damages, unless there is gross negligence or intent on our part.
- 7.) In principle, we organise the run in all weather conditions, but we reserve the right, in coordination with the authorities, to cancel, change the planned form of or abandon the Vienna Calling 21k in case of danger or changes in legal regulations.
- 8.) If the event has to be cancelled, ÖLV will refund the entry fee. Should you not be able to participate in the event for whatever reason, you will not be entitled to a refund.
- 11.) We want to be as flexible as possible and react well to possible new requirements. Organisational changes can therefore also be made at short notice.

## Data protection

1.) Your personal data entered during registration for the Vienna Calling 21k (first name, surname, date of birth, gender, club if applicable) will be stored and processed for the purpose of implementing and managing the event.

When registering via the registration portal of the ÖLV, ATHMIN, as well as via the registration platform of the Enterprise Sport Promotion GmbH, Njuko SAS, your data will be stored in compliance with the DSGVO. This also applies to the bank or credit card data required for payment processing.

2.) Your participant data will be linked to a start number and passed on to Time Now Sports OG as well as to Enterprise Sport Promotion GmbH for the purpose of timekeeping, start number printing, start number distribution, creation of the starter and result lists as well as their publication on [www.vienna-marathon.com](http://www.vienna-marathon.com) or [www.time-now-sports.at](http://www.time-now-sports.at).

3.) Your participant data will also be linked to the "Safe Guest Management Tool", operated by A1 and MTMS Solutions GmbH, and processed for the purpose of participant check-in, accreditation and for the upload and verification of Covid-19 tests. This data is stored for 14 days for documentation purposes. Afterwards, your data will be irretrievably deleted.

4.) We will take pictures and videos at the event and, if necessary, publish them on our own websites and social media channels or pass them on to the media. You can revoke your consent with effect for the future and request the deletion of individual photos. It may also be that private individuals or photographers take photos during the event in which you are depicted. As we have no contractual relationship with these persons, we have no influence on the use of these photos.

## **Covid-19 Rules**

**The Covid-19 prevention concept for the Vienna Calling 21k requires all participants, the organising team and media representatives to present a valid antigen or PCR test. As a pilot project, an electronic model will be used to collect the test proofs. The event will be held in accordance with §15 of the Covid-19 Protective Measures Ordinance.**

Furthermore, when participating in the Vienna Calling 21k, be sure to adhere to the following Covid-19 rules of conduct:

- 1. Keep the minimum distance of 2 metres outside the race wherever possible.**
- 2. FFP2 masks are mandatory at the race number collection, at the start, in the finish area and wherever you have to deal with other people outside the race, indoors and outdoors.**
3. The current regulations of the Austrian Ministry of Health apply
4. Act responsibly and only start the race in good health.
5. If you are travelling by public transport, follow the instructions of the Wiener Linien.
6. Bring your own disinfectant or use the dispensers provided by us.
7. Leave the finish area quickly after the race and use the surrounding areas for rest and recuperation.
8. Stop at the aid station after the race and then take a few steps to the side so that the next runners have easy access.
9. Follow the instructions of our staff and pay attention to the information announcements of the moderator.
10. Please help us to avoid crowds. Do not announce your start, e.g. on social media, and come with as few accompanying persons as possible. If you do bring someone, please ask them to spread out along the route to avoid crowds, especially at the finish.
