# 4 Bib Numbers WITHOUT a timing chip

(e.g., 333A, 333B, 333C, 333D)

- The first runner wears bib A, the second runner wears bib B, etc.
- This bib number should be attached to the front of your shirt (you can use the safety pins for this purpose). The individual number is your personal identification as a relay participant.



# 1 smaller Bib Number WITH a timing chip

(e.g., 333)

- This bib number is worn by your team from the beginning to the end of the race to track your team time.
- At the relay exchange points, you will pass only this number to the next runner in your team.
- >>> We suggest using the bib number belt in the envelope to easily pass the bib between runners.
- >> You can keep the bib number belt after the run!
